



## Cumulative Indexes of Debates in the Commons and Lords

*EPM Cumulative Indexes of Debates in the Commons and Lords* indexes all the debates on education in the House of Commons and the House of Lords from 1 January to 31 December, 2020. It is a cumulative record of debates previously reported in *EPM Weekly Debates*. Because the *EPM Cumulative* sections contain much more information than the *EPM Weekly* sections, the 10 sections in the weekly edition are turned into 22 sections for the cumulative edition. The single section of *EPM Weekly Debates* is split between 11 sections in the *EPM Cumulative* edition, with separate sections for a range of debates, legislation, Motions, oral questions, oral Ministerial statements, petitions, Urgent Questions and Westminster Hall debates.

The information in this section starts with a list of the sections in the cumulative edition that list data first published in *EPM Weekly Debates*. This is followed by four indexes, two each covering the House of Commons and the House of Lords. One set of indexes lists debates by date, the other by subject in alphabetical order. In all four indexes the final column gives a two-letter code identifying which section of *EPM Cumulative* the activity is reported in. The final part of this section gives the meaning of abbreviations found in the various sections of the cumulative and weekly editions of *Education Parliamentary Monitor*.

For ease of reference, the cumulative edition uses the same debate reference numbers (found at the end of each debate report) as the weekly edition. (Ref: EPMC960)
